While it is true that Italy mandates cigarette packages to display health warnings, including "Smoking kills," this requirement is based on the European Union's Tobacco Products Directive (2001/37/EC), which set the framework for health warnings on tobacco products.

However, the claim that this requirement came into effect in 2007 is incorrect. Italy only fully implemented these regulations with Decree No. 6 of 2016, long after the 2007 date mentioned in the claim.
